2-YEAR PPOGRAM THESIS AND NON-THESIS OPTION

- The M.Ed. in Educational Administration and Leadership Program is designed to prepare professional administrators in a school or in an educational organization who will provide leadership in the instructional process.
- Approximately seventy five percent of students are international students.
- Visiting professors from famous universities abroad are invited to teach in the program.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Completed application form with 6 photos (1"x 1 1/2")
- 2. Three copies of Home-Registration (Thai) or Passport
- 3. Three copies of official transcripts and three copies of the certificate of a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution with a GPA of at least 2.5 on a scale of 4
- 4. Two letters of recommendation from two different people who
- Take the AU-English Proficiency Test and the interview. The applicants who submitted the TOEFL (iBT) 90 or (P) 575 or IELTS 6.5 or those with the Bachelor's or Master's Degree from USA, Canada, UK, Australia, and New Zealand are exempted from the AU English Proficiency Test.
